
This 4<sup>th</sup> of July the Lone Tree Police Department had the opportunity to power its Regional Command Center van, which it shares with three other law enforcement jurisdictions, with a mobile solar power generator built and provided by SolaRover, Inc. ([www.solarover.com](http://www.solarover.com)).

The solar generator provided power for the entire mobile command center for nearly 13 continuous hours even though the day saw little direct sunshine and suffered a major rainstorm late in the day. Power was never interrupted or lost and the mobile command center was powered from mid-morning to nearly 11:00 p.m. the same evening when it was removed from the event location. The command center used 2 air conditioning units, a refrigerator, microwave, lights, a continuous rooftop strobe, laptop computers, mobile radio battery chargers and a radio unit. The solar generator was completely silent and produced zero emissions of any kind. The solar unit was pulled up next to the command center and simply plugged in. The command center's on-board fuel generator was never used or even turned on.

With the SolaRover unit fully equipped with batteries and high capacity solar panels, it was clear that clean, silent, portable solar power is a viable option for essential services like powering a mobile law enforcement command center, even in bad weather and during nighttime hours.

We appreciate the opportunity to be part of this clean and green field demonstration.
